For each of the sections below, determine whether or not you could answer some of the questions by reading your partner's annotation:

- **Description of the source**

- What are the main arguments of the source?
- What is the point of this source?
- What topics are covered in this source?
- If someone asked what this source is about, what would you say based on this annotation?

- **Why the source is relevant and useful**

- Is it a useful source?
- How does it compare with other sources?
- Is the information reliable?
- What is the goal of this source?

- **Summary of what the reader learned from the source**

- Was this source helpful?
- How can will this source be used in the research project?
- Has this source informed what the researcher thinks about the topic?
